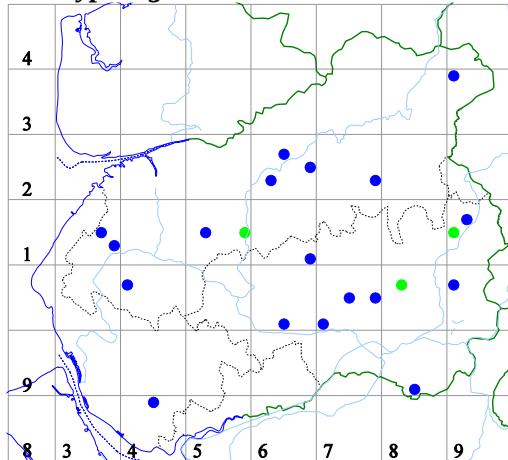


MYRTACEAE

Myrtle family

Status & distribution: Neophyte-surviving; widely planted.

Earliest record traced: Woodland east of Stretton Way Huyton (SJ4589, Anon, 2000).

Habitat: Amenity tree plantings in parks and churchyards.

Comments: Native of Tasmania.

Status & distribution: Neophyte-surviving, planted; Calderstones Park,

Malus and Crataegus area 5 (SJ402875, A Mitchell & V Hallett, 1988).

Comments: Native to Australia within New South Wales and Victoria.

Status & distribution: Neophyte-surviving, planted; Court Hey Park (SJ4190 SJ McWilliam, 2020); Calderstones Park (SJ4087, SJ McWilliam, 2024).
