
## **TAMARICACEAE** Tamarisk family

Status & distribution: Neophyte-surviving; planted at intervals along or nearby to the coast from Aigburth (SJ3885) to Banks (SD31Z); rare further inland with a single record from Woodlands Road (SD80K, AR Locksley & C Walsh, 2004).

**Earliest record traced:** Ainsdale (*SD31B*, JD Massey, 1922, LIV).

**Habitat:** In hedgerows, amenity areas and parks on sandy soils generally nearby to the sea.

**Comments:** Native to the Mediterranean.
